Mr. and Mrs. I. W. Snook are in receipt of a telegram from Mr. Snook, announcing the death of their little daughter Josephine, of pneumonia.

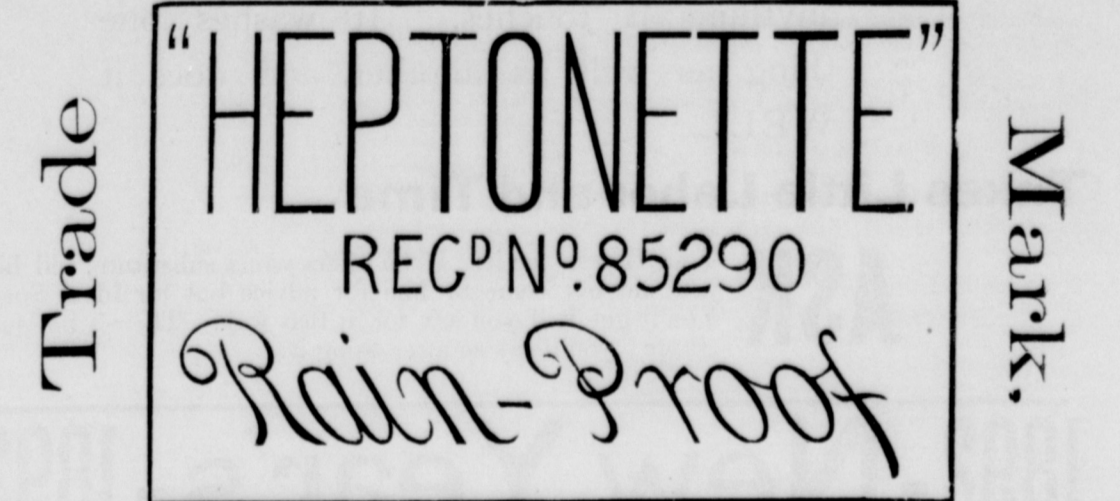
The little one was little over three years of age, and was by adoption the child of Mrs. Snook's sister, Mrs. Cheeny, who is a resident of Mexico.
