Mrs. Duval Whelpley went to St. John on Monday. The willing workers of St. James' church intend having a bazaar for the sale of the 24th.

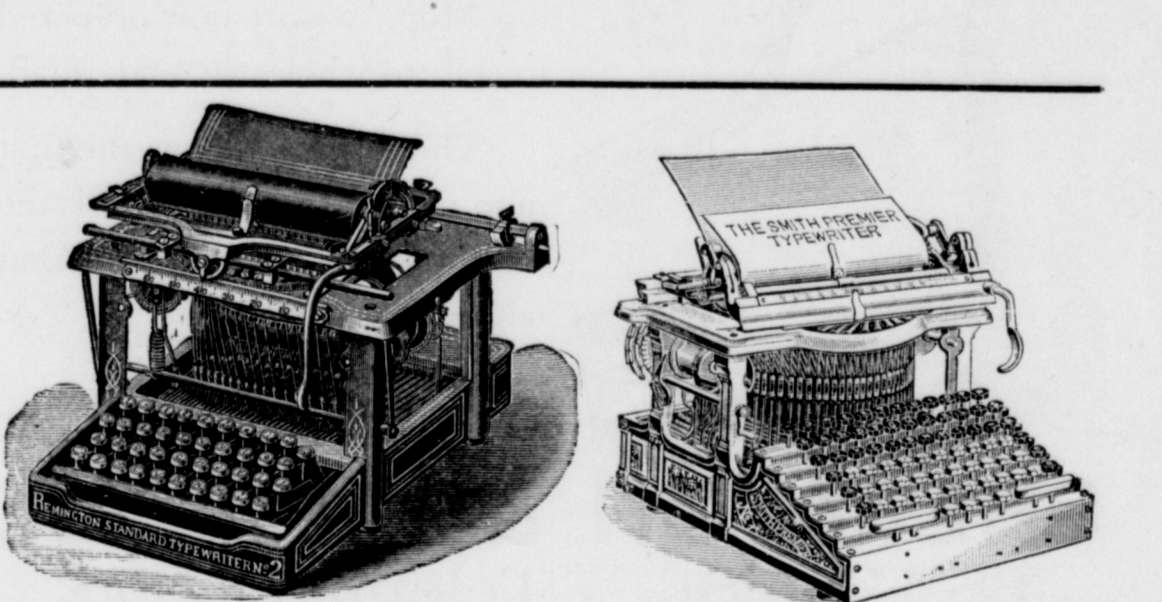
