Mr. Harland and family have returned from the beaches, Pictou, where they have been for the summer.

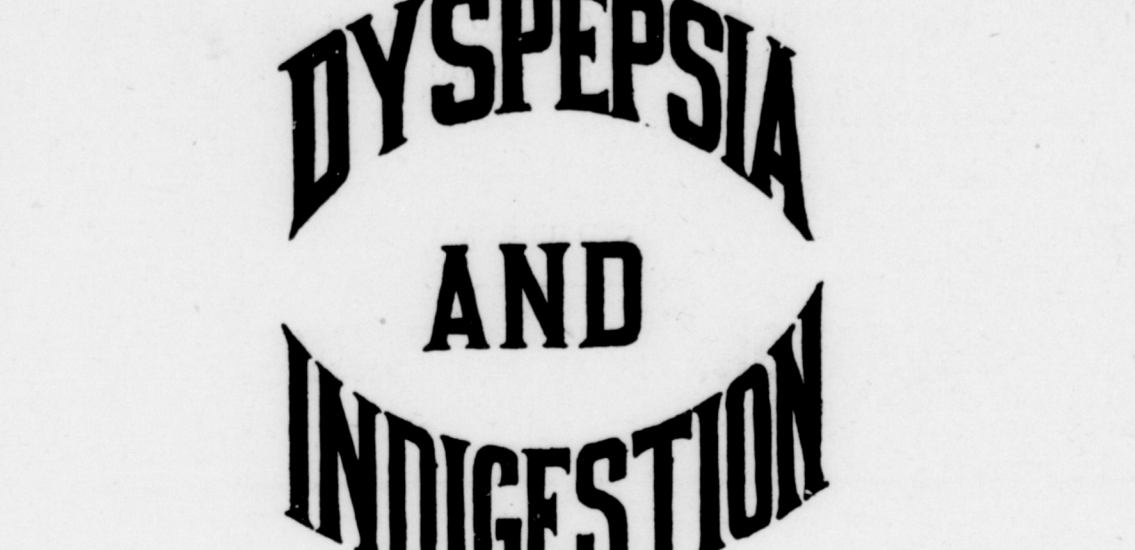
