ORDER IN CHANCERY.

24th JUNE, 1839.

IT IS ORDERED by His Excellency the Chancellor, by and with the advice and consent of His Honor the Master of the Rolls, that when the Defendant is not served with process, and proceedings are to be had under an Act made and passed in the forty eighth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Third, intituled "An Act for making process in Courts of Equity effectual against persons who reside out of the Province, and cannot be served therewith," and also an Act in addition thereto, made and passed in the third year of the reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, or either of them, in case the appearance is not entered within thirty days after the last day on which the subpoena issued may be served, under the eighth order of this Court of the fourth day of June instant, the like proceedings may be had as are authorised by the said Acts, or either of them, in case the appearance of the defendant be not entered within the time mentioned and prescribed in that behalf in the said Acts, or either of them respectively.

And it is further ordered, That the foregoing order do take effect on and after the first day of July next and not sooner.
