MILITIA GENERAL ORDERS.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief has been pleased to direct that the 2d Battalion Northumberland Militia, commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Davidson, be divided into two separate and distinct Battalions, and the Districts to be as follows:—

The Second Battalion to commence at the Mouth of Renou's River, from thence down the Miramichi River to its old bounds, and including the North West Branch of the Miramichi.

The Third Battalion to commence at the Mouth of Renou's River aforesaid, to include the Settlements on the said River, and from thence to extend up the main South West Branch of the Miramichi to the County line.

Major James Gilmore, from the 1st Battalion Northumberland Militia, to be Lieutenant Colonel Commandant of the new or 3d Battalion.

2d Battalion Westmorland.

William Atkinson, to be Ensign, vice William Chapman, promoted, dated 1st April, 1840, to take precedence of Otho Sayre.

The Christian name of Ensign Brophy, who was appointed to the 1st Battalion Northumberland Militia on the 8th March, 1839, is Patrick, and not James.
