### Commissioners for expending Bye Road Grants.

#### COUNTY OF RESTIGOUCHE.

Joseph Hunter, Esquire, to expend the following sums:  
£50 for the road from James Christopher's to the Flat Lands.  
£100 for the road from the Flat Lands to the commencement of the line to be explored to the Upsalquitche River.  
£50 for the road from Christopher's Brook to the Settlement on the Portage Road leading to the Forks of the Upsalquitche River.  
£20 for the road leading to the Sugar Loaf Mountain Settlement.
