HEREAS representations have been made to His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, that Licenced Teachers of Parish Schools, who have either relinquished the Schools in which they have been employed, or have been dismissed therefrom, and, under their present Licences, have frequently sought employment, as Teachers, in other parts of the Country, where they were unknown, and this, without any explanation of the causes of their removal; -His Excellency is pleased to prohibit this practice in future, and to direct, that Licenced Teachers, leaving a School in which they have been engaged, and seeking employment as Teachers elsewhere, shall procure from the Trustees of the School, in which they have been teaching, a certificate specifying the reasons of their leaving, and stating what their conduct had been during the period of their employment; which certificate and testimonial HEREAS the General Assembly of they propose to make a new engagement; and, this Province stands prorogued to in case of removal to another County, also to to have infringed this Regulation, to which the particular attention of the several Boards of Education and Trustees of Schools is invoked,
