A PROCLAMATION.

DEFIEREAS a Proclamation, bearing be used at Morning and Evening Service, after date the twenty ninth day of July last, the General Thanksgiving, in all Churches and was issued, commanding all Persons who have Chapels, in the Province of New Brunswick, illegally occupied any Lands reserved by the Crown for the benefit of the Indians, forthwith thereof shall receive the same :-to guit the same, and to abstain from cutting or removing Timber therefrom ; And whereas it is expedient furthermore effectually to prevent the infraction of the prohibition; I do therefore hereby require and strictly command all Persons whatsoever to abstain from cutting or removing any Timber from the said reserved Lands without Licence, or from otherwise tres passing thereon upon any pretence whatsoever : And I do further require and command all seizing Officers to be vigilent in detecting any trespasses that may be committed on any of the said reserved Lands, and promptly to seize all Timber that may be found to have been cut thereon, without Licence for that purpose first obtained. 
