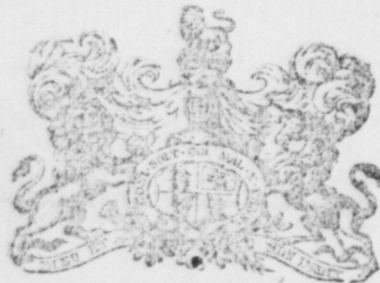

AN application having been lately made to the Lieutenant Governor, by thirty-four persons, who have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a New Settlement upon a Tract of Vacant Crown Land; Orders have been issued by His Excellency in Council, directing the Surveyor General to Survey the tract applied for into Fifty Acre Lots, and to be offered for Sale at Auction, at the upset price of Three Shillings per acre together with three pence per acre, to defray the expense of Survey; and Bonds to the Queen will be taken upon legal interest, payable in advance.—It was also further Ordered, That notice be given to applicants for Land in other parts of the Province, that upon similar Associations being formed, the Government will take into consideration the disposal of the Lands, and the opening of the Roads thereto, upon similar terms.
