An Act to revive an Act, intituled An Act for regulating the Salmon Fisheries in the County 3 W. 4, c. 27. of Gloucester.

Passed 31st March 1842.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governer, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled An Act for regulating the Salmon 3 W. 4, c. 27, Fisheries in the County of Gloucester, be and the same is hereby revived and declared to be in full force and effect until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
