## GENERAL RULE.

*Delivery of Pleadings.*

**I**T is Ordered, that in future Copies of all Pleas shall be delivered to the Plaintiff's Attorney within the time allowed for Pleadings, otherwise the Plaintiff shall be at liberty (demand of Plea being duly made) to sign Interlocuting Judgment; and that it shall not be necessary to search for a Plea before such signing after the expiration of the Rule to Plead.
