**THOS. BAILLIE, Surveyor General.****A BILL****FOR THE DIVISION OF THE COUNTY OF WESTMORLAND INTO TWO COUNTIES,****AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE GOVERNMENT AND REPRESENTATION OF THE NEW COUNTY.**

**W**HEREAS from the great extent of the present County of Westmorland, and from other causes, it is necessary and expedient that the same be divided into two Counties;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That all that part of the said County which lies westerly of the Petitcodiac River in the said County, as far up the said River as

be and the same is hereby erected into a County, separate and distinct from the said County of Westmorland, and shall be called and known by the name of the County of —, and that the residue of the said County shall comprise the said County of Westmorland.

And be it enacted, That the like Courts of Justice shall be erected and established, and the like Justices and other Officers shall be constituted and appointed in the said new County, as are now erected and established, constituted and appointed in the said County of Westmorland, and with the like powers and authorities.

And be it enacted, That the Courts of Nisi Prius and General Gaol Delivery shall be holden in the Shire Town of the said new County, on the — Tuesday in — in every year; and that the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Courts of Common Pleas, shall be holden in the said new County twice in every year, at the times following that is to say:—on the first Tuesday in June, and first Tuesday in December; and continue until the business shall be finished, not exceeding five days; and that
