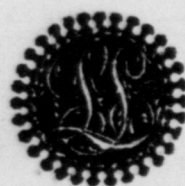

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to the last Tuesday in this instant month of September; I have thought fit further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued to the third Tuesday in December next.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Fredericton, the twentieth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four, and in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor of Her Majesty's Province of New Brunswick, with the Council and Assembly of the said Province, did in the months of March and April last, pass seven Acts, which have been transmitted, entitled as follows, viz:—

No. 1483. An Act imposing Duties for raising a Revenue.

No. 1488. An Act to authorize the Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry of Saint Ann's Church, in the Parish of Sackville, to sell certain Lots of Glebe Land, and to dispose of the money arising from the sale thereof in the purchase of other Lands.

No. 1508. An Act to revive certain Acts relating to the prevention of the importation and spreading of Infectious Distempers within the Counties of Charlotte and Northumberland, and to extend the provision of the same to the Counties of Gloucester and Restigouche.

No. 1509. An Act to amend an Act imposing Duties for raising a Revenue.

No. 1510. An Act to prevent the spread of a disorder now existing in certain parts of the Counties of Gloucester and Northumberland.

No. 1515. An Act to encourage the Fisheries of this Province.

No. 1521. An Act to amend an Act intituled, An Act to make more effectual Regulations relating to Pilots within this Province.

And whereas the said Acts have been referred to the Committee of the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council appointed for the consideration of all matters relating to Trade and Foreign Plantations, and the said Committee have reported as their opinion to Her Majesty that the said Acts should be left to their operation; Her Majesty was thereupon this day pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve the said Report: Whereof the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, of Her Majesty's Province of New Brunswick, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
