ANNO SEPTIMO VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

CAP. 1.

An Act imposing Duties for raising a Revenue.

Passed 25th March 1844.

TE, Her Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Assembly of New Brunswick in General Assembly convened, for raising the necessary ' supplies to defray the expences of Her Majesty's Government within this ' Province, have freely resolved to give and grant to the Queen's Most Excellent ' Majesty, the several Rates and Duties on the Schedule hereinafter mentioned, ' and do therefore pray Your Excellency that it may be enacted ;'

I. And be it enacted by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, by and with Dutles granted for the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly, and by the vince and the supauthority of the same, That on and after the first day of April which will be in this port of the Governpresent year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four, there be and are hereby granted to the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, for the use of this Province, and for the support of the Government thereof, the several Rates and Duties described and set forth in the Table of Duties hereinafter contained, denominated Table of Colonial Duties and Exemptions from Duty, opposite to and against the respective Articles in the said Table or Schedule mentioned, described and enumerated, and according to the value, number or quantity of such Articles therein specified, whether imported or brought into this Province either by Sea, Inland Navigation or by Land, from any part of the British Empire, or from any Foreign port or place, or which may be saved from any wreck, or stranded Ship or Vessel. II. And be it enacted, That the several Duties herein before imposed, and in To be in addition to the said Table or Schedule mentioned, shall be paid by the importer or importers by Acts of Parof such Articles respectively, and shall be held and taken to be in addition to and liament. over and above any Duties which are or may be imposed and collected by any Act or Acts of the Imperial Parliament, now or hereafter to be in force, and also over and above any Duties which are or may be otherwise imposed and collected by any other Act or Acts of the General Assembly of this Province, passed or to be passed, or now or hereafter to be in force, and shall be collected and secured by means and under the regulations and penalties, and shall be drawn back on exportation or warehoused, in the way and manner provided by any Act or Acts of the General Assembly for collecting the Revenue of this Province. III. And be it enacted, That all Goods which shall have been warehoused in Warehoused goods this Province before this Act comes into operation, and which shall remain so have not been secuwarehoused after the operation thereof commences, and on which the Provincial red to be liable to Daties imposed by Duties heretofore imposed have not been paid or secured by a subsisting or continuing security, shall in lieu of all former Duties, become liable to and be charged with Provincial Duties hereby imposed on the like Goods and Merchandize, and shall be paid at the time of taking such Goods and Merchandize out of the Warehouse.

IV. And be it enacted, That when any Articles that shall have been warehoused, Duties to be repaid or Warehouse Bond or on which Duties shall have been paid under this or any other previous Act, cancelled as to goods shall be exported for the use of the Deep Sea or Whale Fisheries, the amount of Deep Sea Fisheries. **Ro.** 119.
