8th.—All persons having Licence to cut Timber on Crown Lands, and who shall have worked the same auring the previous year, and who may apply for their old ground before the previous Licence expires, may receive a renewal of such Licence for the whole or part of their old ground, at the discretion of the Government, by private sale, at ten shillings per square mile.
