## NEW BRUNSWICK, IN CHANCERY.

In the matter of the Estate of Henry Smith, deceased, who died intestate.

**W**HEREAS by an Order of the Master of the Rolls, made in the High Court of Chancery of this Province, dated the eighth day of October, A. D. 1845, whereby after reciting that upon consideration that day had by the said Court, on the Petition of George Shore, George Minchin, and John Simpson, Executors of the last Will and Testament of Samuel Grosvenor, late of Fredericton, deceased, setting forth among other things, that Henry Smith, late of Saint Mary's, in the said County of York, died intestate, on or about the thirteenth day of February, A.
