

their instructions except in forcing the River Parana. This measure, it is said, has received the condemnation of both Governments, who have however at the same time promoted their officers who were in the hard fought battle.

It is said at Montevideo, that England is unwilling to establish the precedent of forcing the passage of the River Parana, when Buenos Ayres has territory on both its banks at the entrance, as it would at once establish the right of the United States to the navigation of the St. Lawrence.
