

sealing the said Indenture of Lease in the presence of two credible witnesses, as consenting parties thereto respectively.

IV. And be it enacted, That nothing in this Act contained shall extend or be construed to extend in any manner to confer any spiritual jurisdiction or ecclesiastical rights whatsoever upon the said Roman Catholic Bishop hereinbefore mentioned, or upon his successor or successors, or other ecclesiastical person of the said Church, in communion with the Church of Rome aforesaid.

V. And be it enacted, That in case the said Roman Catholic Bishop, or his successor or successors, shall, from sickness, infirmity or any other cause, become incapable of or be incapacitated from performing his or their duties in his Diocese, then his Coadjutor, or the person administering the Diocese, shall have the same powers as are by this Act conferred upon the Roman Catholic Bishop of the said Diocese.

VI. And be it enacted, That nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect in any manner or way the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors, or of any person or persons whomsoever, or of any body politic or corporate, or of any Church Wardens, or Auditors of Accounts, in any Roman Catholic Church in this Province, or in any way to abridge, diminish or take away any of the rights, privileges and advantages now enjoyed and possessed by any pewholder, or any person having any right, title or interest in any pew or sitting in any Roman Catholic Church or Chapel in this Province, such only excepted as are hereinbefore mentioned and provided for.

VII. And be it enacted, That this Act shall not come in force or be in operation until Her Majesty's Royal approbation be thereunto had and declared.

[This Act was specially confirmed, ratified and finally enacted by an Order of Her Majesty in Council, dated the 6th day of July, 1846.]

Act not to confer any spiritual jurisdiction, &c.

Corporate powers to be exercised by the person administering the Diocese during any incapacity of the Bishop.

Rights of Her Majesty, Wardens, Auditors of Accounts, &c. reserved.

Act suspended until Her Majesty's approbation be declared.

GOVERNMENT NOTICE.

REGULATIONS for the disposal of Timber and Lumber, under the 5th Section of the Act, 8th Wm. 4, cap. 1:—

1st. After the 15th day of August next, all applications for License of Grounds remaining unsold from the July sales, shall be made by Petition, which shall describe the situation of the ground, and specify the number of Square Miles required by the applicant. No Petition to be for more than ten, nor less than two Square Miles.

2d. One application only to be received at the Surveyor General's Office for the same ground.

3d. Every applicant on filing his Petition, shall deposit with the Receiver General the sum of ten shillings upon each Square Mile applied for, and should the party so depositing become the purchaser at Auction, such deposit shall be applied toward the payment of the purchase money. And in case the ground so applied for, shall not be purchased at the time advertised for the sale thereof, the deposit so made shall be forfeited; and in case some other person than the depositor, shall become the purchaser, and comply with the terms of sale, the amount so deposited shall be forthwith refunded to the party who may have paid the same.

A description Ticket, as heretofore will be given to the purchaser.

4th. All Berths applied for shall, if vacant, be advertised in the Royal Gazette, semi-monthly, and at least fourteen days notice of sale given; and unless the whole of the purchase money be paid by the purchaser to the Receiver General, at the time of the sale, such sale shall be void, and the ground may forthwith be put up again for competition between any other parties, the upset price being in all cases ten shillings per Square Mile.

5th. All Timber, Logs or other Lumber cut upon unlicensed Crown Lands, or which may be cut by any person beyond the limits of his own Berth, shall be seized and forfeited to the use of the Crown, and no Timber or Lumber shall be cut on any Berth applied for, until the Mileage be paid, and the description Ticket issued.
