REMARKS.—The income of the Ministers is derived chiefly from Pew Rents and Collections. The Colonial Society of Glasgow, and more recently, the General Assembly's Colonial Committee, have, in some instances, where the case was urgent, made a small temporary grant. The Scottish Establishment in this Province receives no pecuniary aid from Her Majesty's Government. A small grant of Wilderness Land only, has been made to each Church that was in existence previous to 1836.

There are numbers of Presbyterians scattered over various parts of the Province: but who not being so concentrated as to erect a Church and support a Minister, or being too far removed from any Church already existing, cannot be comprehended in the above Return.
