### A PROCLAMATION.

**W**HEREAS it appears from an Inquest held before William Bayard, Esquire, Coroner of our Lady the Queen for the City of Saint John, on the tenth day of February instant, on view of the body of a new born Male Child, then and there lying dead, that some person or persons unknown did make an assault on the said child, being alive, and by exposure to the cold and snow in a certain passage way in the said City, and then and there deserting and abandoning the said child, so being alive, did then and there feloniously, wilfully, and of malice aforethought, cause the death of the said child:

I do therefore publish this Proclamation, and do hereby offer a Reward of Fifty Pounds to whomsoever shall give such information of the Person or Persons by whom such offence was committed, as may lead to the apprehension and conviction of the offender.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Fredericton, the twenty fourth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six, and in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
