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GOVERNMENT NOTICE.

THE attention of the Supervisors and Commissioners of Bye Roads is hereby called to the following Instructions, and to the second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth clauses of the Act 9 Vict. cap. 55, to which they are enjoined strictly to adhere; and on sending in their Accounts to the *Auditor General*, as required, they are to make Reports to the Lieutenant Governor of the state of the Roads, in which Reports are to be noted any alterations that may have been made in the Roads under their charge, the state of the Bridges on the Lines, and when practicable, each Report to be accompanied by a Diagram or Survey on which the sites of the Bridges are to be distinctly marked.
