A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it appears by an Inquest held before Peter C.
Amiraux and Vital Thibideau, Esquires, two of Her Majesty's
Justices of the Peace for the County of Carleton, on view of the
body of Douglas Balloch, deceased, that the said Douglas Balloch
came to his death by the discharge of a Gun, loaded with Gun-
powder, a Lead Bullet, some Buck-shot and Duck-shot, on the
night of the eleventh of October last, fired off by some person or
persons unknown; I do therefore publish this Proclamation, and
do hereby offer a Reward of One Hundred Pounds to whomsoever
shall give such information to Her Majesty's Attorney General, of
the person or persons by whom the offence was committed, as will
enable him to prosecute the Offender or Offenders to conviction.
