

in such Government Emigration Agents by the said recited Act or by any other Act shall vest in and be exercised by the "Emigration Officers" for the Time being, in like Manner as if they bore the Designation of Government Emigration Agent.

XV. And be it enacted, That whenever the Term "Passenger" or "Passage" is used in this Act it shall be held not to include or extend to the Class of Passengers or Passages commonly known and understood, by the Name of "Cabin Passengers" and "Cabin Passages;" and that the Term "Ship" shall include and mean every Description of Vessel, whether *British* or Foreign, carrying Passengers upon any Voyage to which the Provisions of the said herein-before recited Passengers Act or this Act shall for the time being extend.

XVI. And be it enacted, That this Act may be amended or repealed during the present Session of Parliament.
