

this Act, it shall and may be lawful for any Constable of such Town, Parish or Place, and he is hereby enjoined and required, on notice thereof given him by any of the Inhabitants, to apprehend and convey, or cause to be conveyed, such person so offending to a Justice of the Peace of the County, in order to be examined and proceeded against according to Law: and if any Constable after such notice given as aforesaid, shall refuse or neglect to use his best endeavours to apprehend and convey such offenders before a Justice of the Peace as aforesaid, being thereof legally convicted before such Justice of the Peace, every such Constable shall forfeit and pay to the use of the Poor thereof, the sum of Ten Shillings, to be levied by distress and sale of the offender's Goods, by warrant from such Justice, and the overplus, if any, after the charge of prosecution and of such distress, shall be satisfied, shall be returned to such offender.

IV.—And be it further enacted, That any person or persons who shall conceive him, her or themselves aggrieved by any act, judgment or determination of any Justice or Justices of the Peace out of Sessions, in and concerning the execution of this Act, may appeal to the next General Quarter Sessions of the City or County, on finding two sufficient securities in Ten Pounds each, to prosecute such appeal to effect.
