to appropriate and apply such monies so as aforesaid received for such debts from time to time in the payment of a certain number of the said Debentures, with the interest due thereon, in their due order as aforesaid, causing the like notice to be given as aforesaid.

IX. And be it enacted, That after the said Clock is so set up as aforesaid, the Expenses of mainexpenses of keeping the same in repair, and of taking care of the same, and any to be paid from and every contingent expence incident thereto, shall be annually defrayed and paid for out of the County Funds of the County of York, in such manner as the Justices of the Peace of the said County of York, shall from time to time order and direct.

X. And be it enacted, That the County Treasurer of the County of York shall Remuneration of the County be entitled to receive the sum of two per cent. for paying and receiving all monies Treasurer. collected under the authority of this Act.

CAP. XXXVII.

An Act to authorize Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the County of Charlotte to assess the inhabitants of said County to pay off the County Debt, and to provide for the contingent expenses thereof.

Passed 30th March 1848.

TDE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the County of Charlotte, at authorized, to pay any General Sessions to be hereafter holden, be and they are hereby authorized Debt and continand empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding four gent expenses. hundred pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary, for the purpose of paying off the County Debt, and contingent expenses of the said County; the same to be assessed, levied, collected and paid agreeably to any Acts now or hereafter to be in force for assessing, collecting, levying and paying of the County Rates.

CAP. XXXVIII.

An Act to enable the Justices of the Peace for the County of Carleton to pay certain expenses incurred in preserving the Peace in said County.

Passed 30th March 1848.

THEREAS the Justices of the Peace of the County of Carleton incurred Preamble. a heavy expense in preserving the Peace in the said County in July ' last, a large part of which it is proposed to pay by a Legislative Grant, and the ' remainder by assessment upon the County of Carleton;' I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assessment of not Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of Carleton, at any authorized to be exceeding £591 10s General Sessions of the Peace hereafter holden, be and they are hereby authorized made, to defray expenses of preand empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding five serving the Peace, hundred and ninety one pounds ten shillings, in such sums and at such times as they in their discretion may deem necessary, for defraying the expenses incurred in preserving the Peace in the said County in July last, to be assessed, levied, collected and paid agreeably to any Law in force for collecting and levying County or Parish Rates. II. And be it enacted, That notwithstanding the provisions of any Act or Acts One fifth may be assessed as a Poll now in force for levying, assessing and collecting County and Parish Rates, the Tax. Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace for the County of Carleton shall have full power and authority, if they in their discretion shall see fit, to assess one fifth of any assessment to be made under this Act, upon the polls of the inhabitants of the said County.

CAP. XXXIX.

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for King's County to levy an assessment to pay off the County Debts.

Passed 30th March 1848.

E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, Assessment autho-That the Justices of the Peace for King's County, at any General Sessions County Debt. of the Peace to be hereafter holden, or at any Special Sessions to be for that purpose convened, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding two hundred pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary, for paying off the debts due from the said County; the same to be assessed, levied and paid agreeably to and under and by virtue of any Act or Acts which are now or hereafter may be in force in this Province for assessing, levying and collecting the Rates for public charges.
