CAP. X.

An Act to continue the several Acts for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton.

Passed 11th April 1850.

E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, Acts 9 V. c 40, and That an Act made and passed in the ninth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled An Act to provide for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock, and also an Act made and passed in the tenth year of the same Reign, intituled An Act in addition to and in amendment of an 10 V.c 15, Act, intituled 'An Act to provide for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock,' be and the same are hereby respectively continued and declared to be in force until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five.
