## CAP. X.

An Act to continue the several Acts for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton.

Passed 11th April 1850.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the ninth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to provide for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock*, and also an Act made and passed in the tenth year of the same Reign, intituled *An Act in addition to and in amendment of an Act, intituled 'An Act to provide for the repair of the Streets and Highways in part of the Parish of Woodstock,'* be and the same are hereby respectively continued and declared to be in force until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five.

## CAP. XI.

An Act to provide for more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in a part of the Parish of Richibucto.

Passed 11th April 1850.

**I. B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That all persons liable to perform labour on the Streets and Highways in that part of the Parish of Richibucto, in the County of Kent, which is included within the following limits, to-wit:—Commencing on the south side of
