and Goods, under the Act or Acts of Parliament in such case made
or to be made and provided, and subject to the Regulations estab-
lished by the Imperial Customs in that behalf.

seventeenth day of April, in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and fifty, and in the thir-
teenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
