7 HEREAS the General Assembly of this Province has been summoned to meet at Fredericton on Thursday the eleventh day of this instant July, I have thought fit to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued to Thursday the twenty sixth day of September next.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at Fredericton, the third day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and in the fourteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
