WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands
prorogued to the second Tuesday of this present month of
September, I have thought fit further to prorogue the said General
Assembly, and the same is further prorogued to the last Tuesday
in November next.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at Fredericton, the
second day of September, in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and fifty one, and in the
fifteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor of Her Majesty's Pro-
vince of New Brunswick, with the Council and Assembly
of the said Province, did, in the month of April 1851, pass four
Acts, which have been transmitted, entitled as follows, viz:—

No. 2066. An Act to provide for the establishment of Muni-
cipal Authorities in this Province.

No. 2067. An Act to suspend the operation of certain provisions
of the Militia Laws.

No. 2068. An Act to extend the privilege of solemnizing Mar-
riage to all Ministers and Teachers of the several Religious Con-
gregations in this Province.

No. 2069. An Act in amendment of An Act entitled "An Act
for the better prevention of Illicit Trade."

And whereas the said Acts have been referred to the Committee
of the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council
appointed for the consideration of all matters relating to Trade
and Foreign Plantations, and the said Committee have reported as
their opinion to Her Majesty, that the said Acts should receive
Her Majesty's special confirmation; Her Majesty was thereupon
this day pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to
declare Her special confirmation of the said Acts, and the same
are hereby specially confirmed, ratified, and finally enacted ac-
cordingly: Whereof the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Com-
mander in Chief for the time being, of Her Majesty's Province of
New Brunswick, and all other persons whom it may concern, are
to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
