The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty, His Royal Highness Prince ALBERT,

Lord Chancellor, Lord President, Lord Privy Seal, Duke of Norfolk, Lord Steward, Marquis of Abercorn, Earl of Carlisle,

Earl Grey, Lord John Russell, Viscount Palmerston, Lord Broughton, Sir Francis Baring, Bt. Mr. Chancellor of the Exchequer.

THEREAS the Lieutenant Governor of Her Majesty's Province of New Brunswick, with the Council and Assembly of the said Province, did, in the month of April 1851, pass four Acts, which have been transmitted, entitled as follows, viz:

No. 2066. An Act to provide for the establishment of Municipal Authorities in this Province.

No. 2067. An Act to suspend the operation of certain provisions

of the Militia Laws.

No. 2068. An Act to extend the privilege of solemnizing Marriage to all Ministers and Teachers of the several Religious Congregations in this Province.

No. 2069. An Act in amendment of An Act entitled "An Act for the better prevention of Illicit Trade."

And whereas the said Acts have been referred to the Committee of the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council appointed for the consideration of all matters relating to Trade and Foreign Plantations, and the said Committee have reported as their opinion to Her Majesty, that the said Acts should receive 100 acres, lot 39, block 19, Studholm, S. Fowler. Her Majesty's special confirmation; Her Majesty was thereupon | 273 this day pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to declare Her special confirmation of the said Acts, and the same are hereby specially confirmed, ratified, and finally enacted accordingly: Whereof the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, of Her Majesty's Province of New Brunswick, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
