Died,

At Saint John, on Wednesday the 12th instant, at his residence, Princess Street, BENJAMIN L. PETERS, Esquire, in the 63rd year of his age.—Colonel Peters has held many offices of honor and responsibility in the community, having for a time been Mayor of this City, and at his death was Lieutenant Colonel Commandant of the City Militia and Stipendiary Magistrate. He leaves behind him a large family, who, with many friends, deeply regret their loss.

Suddenly, at Spring Park, on the 9th instant, the Honorable EDWARD JAMES JARVIS, for many years Chief Justice of this Island, aged 63 years. The deceased was universally respected for his upright character and astuteness as a Judge; for the urbanity of his manners as a Citizen, and for the mildness of his disposition as a Husband and Parent.
