

To the Keeper of the Light House on Campo Bello, one hundred pounds.

To the Keeper of the Beacon Light, eighty five pounds.

To the Commissioners of Light Houses in the Bay of Fundy, the following sums to pay for the services for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five:—

To the Keeper of the Light House on Gannet Rock and his Assistants, two hundred and ten pounds:

To the Keeper of the Light House on Thrum Cap, Quaco, one hundred and ten pounds, and an additional sum of thirty six pounds to pay an Assistant:

To the Keeper of the Light House on Machias Seal Island, one hundred and thirty pounds, and an additional sum of thirty six pounds to enable him to pay an Assistant:

To the Keeper of the Light House in the Harbour of Saint Andrews, forty pounds:

To the Keeper of the Light House on Cape Enrage, eighty five pounds.

To the Commissioners of Light Houses in the Gulf of Saint Lawrence, one hundred pounds to provide for the salary of a

Keeper for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five at the Light House on Point Escuminac.

2. All the before mentioned sums of money shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Province, by Warrant of the Governor in Council, out of the moneys in the Treasury, or as payment may be made at the same.

CAP. IV.

An Act to continue Chapter Thirty four, Title Three, of the Revised Statutes, "*Of the payment of Interest on Treasury Warrants.*"

Cap. 34., Revised Statutes, continued.

Passed 10th March 1855.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, that Chapter Thirty four, Title Three, "*Of the payment of Interest on Treasury Warrants,*" be and the same is hereby continued in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five.
