#### CAP. I.

An Act to appropriate a part of the Public Revenue towards the Patriotic Fund.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. That there be granted and paid out of the Treasury of this Province, to His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor the sum of five thousand pounds in aid of the Patriotic Fund.

2. The said sum of money shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Province by Warrant of the Governor in Council out of the moneys now in the Treasury.
