

southerly direction to the place of beginning : Which said tracts of land were granted to the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of said Church, by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of this Province, bearing date the twenty first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows :—

1. That the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Saint Mary's Church, in the Parish of Saint Mary, in the County of York, by and with the approbation of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of all or any of the said Glebe Lands described in the Preamble, and to make good and sufficient deeds of conveyance of the same.

2. That the amounts arising from such sale shall be reinvested by the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, in the purchase of other Lands for the purposes of a Glebe for said Church.

CAP. LX.

An Act to authorize the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Christ Church, in the Parish of Fredericton, to sell certain Lands, and reinvest the proceeds thereof.

Section.

1. Sale of certain lands belonging to Christ Church, Fredericton, authorized.

Section.

2. Proceeds to be reinvested.

WHEREAS the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Christ Church, in the Parish of Fredericton, are seized and possessed of a certain tract of land situate in the Parish of Kingsclear, in the County of York, containing about thirty acres, conveyed to them by the Honorable Thomas Baillie, by deed bearing date the thirteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, for the use and purpose of a Glebe for the said Parish of Fredericton; and also of a certain other tract of land situate in the Parish of Fredericton, containing about three hundred and fifty acres, being part of a lot or tract of five hundred acres heretofore granted by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of this Province, and bearing date the ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine, to them the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, as a Glebe for the use of the Rector or Minister of the said Parish for the time being: And whereas it is considered expedient and for the benefit of the Rector or Minister of the said Parish, that the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, should be authorized to sell and dispose of the said two tracts of land;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows :—

1. The Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Christ Church, in the Parish of Fredericton, are hereby authorized and empowered to sell the said two several tracts of land hereinbefore described, being part of the Glebe of the said Parish of Fredericton, and to make and deliver good and sufficient deeds of conveyance of the same in fee simple to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, by and with the consent and approbation

of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese for the time being, to be signified either by his being a party to any such deed of conveyance and signing and sealing the same, or by his endorsing such consent upon any such deed.

2. The proceeds arising from such sale shall be invested by the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, in the purchase of other property for the use and purpose of a Glebe for the said Parish of Fredericton, or be invested by them in mortgages upon real estate for the benefit of the Rector or Minister of the said Parish of Fredericton for the time being.

CAP. LXI.

An Act to authorize and empower the Church Wardens and Vestry of Trinity Church, in Springfield, in King's County, to sell certain Glebe Lands in said Parish, and vest the proceeds in other Lands.

Section.

1. Sale of Glebe of Trinity Church, Springfield, authorized.

Section.

2. Proceeds to be reinvested.

WHEREAS the present Glebe Lands of Trinity Church, in the Parish of Springfield, in King's County, are found to be comparatively valueless to the Rector of said Church by reason of their remoteness therefrom, and it is deemed advisable by the Corporation of said Church to sell and dispose of the same, and to vest the proceeds arising from such sale in other lands;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows :—

1. That the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of said Church, by and with the approbation of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of, at public auction or private sale, all or any part of the present Glebe Lands belonging to the said Church, and give to the purchaser good and sufficient conveyance of the same.

2. The amount arising from such sale shall be invested by the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, in the purchase of other freehold estate, more conveniently situated, for the benefit of the Rector of said Church, to hold the same to the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, for a Glebe for the use of the Rector of said Church for the time being.

CAP. LXII.

An Act relating to the Saint Stephen Railroad Company.

Time for completing Railway extended.

Passed 12th April 1855.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the times mentioned in the eighteenth Section of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Saint Stephen's Railroad Company*, for completing the two different Sections of the said Railroad, shall be and they are hereby respectively extended and continued to the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and sixty six.
