

QUEEN'S and CHARLOTTE.

"CLARENDON."—This Tract consists of 9,000 acres, about fifteen miles from the mouth of the Nerepis River, between the Queen's Lake and the South Oromocto Lake, partly in Queen's, and partly in Charlotte County. It is divided into 91 Lots, intersected by several small Lakes. The numbers are 1 to 48 inclusive.
