A PROCLAMATION.

THEREAS on the fourth day of June instant, a Verdict was rendered by a Coroner's Jury that JOSEPH FOX, a Soldier of Her Majesty's 76th Regiment of Foot, on duty at Musquash, about 13 miles from Saint John, was feloniously, wilfully and of malice afe ethought murdered by some person to the Jurors unknown;

I do therefore publish this Proclamation, and offer a Reward of FIFTY POUNDS to such person or persons as shall give information to the Attorney General, or to any other Officer or Minister of Justice, that shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of the offender.

> Given under my Hand and Seal, at Fredericton, the tenth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, and in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
