Fredericton, August 19, 1857.

REV. AND DEAR BRETHREN,

By an Order of the Queen in Council dated June 15, 1857, agreeably to the provisions of the Act of Uniformity, Her Majesty is pleased to declare Her Royal will and pleasure, that, in all the Prayers, Litanies, and Collects for the Royal Family, the words "The Prince Consort" shall be inserted instead of the words "The Prince Albert."

I desire therefore that you will henceforth use the words as thus altered, and that you will, to prevent mistakes, with the Pen, correct and amend all such Prayers in your Church Books, until new Editions shall be published.
