

custody of, and charge and control over the persons of such children, until they are disposed of in manner directed by an Act of the General Assembly, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Saint John Protestant Orphan Asylum*, passed in the eighteenth year of Her present Majesty's Reign; provided such child or children are placed under the control of said Society by the written consent of the mother of such child or children; and provided always, that said institution shall at all times be open to a full inspection of Commissioners to be appointed by the Executive Government, whenever they may deem it necessary to make such inspection.

CAP. XL.

An Act in addition to an Act intituled *An Act to incorporate the Saint John Suspension Bridge Company*.

Section.

1. Penalty for forcibly passing.

Passed 26th March 1857.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. If any person or persons shall on foot, or with any horse or other animal, with or without a wagon, carriage, sleigh, sled or other vehicle, forcibly pass or attempt to pass any gate of the Saint John Suspension Bridge Company without having paid the legal toll, such person or persons for each and every offence shall forfeit and pay to the said Corporation a sum not more than five pounds and not less than two pounds, together with all costs of suit, to be recovered under the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Chapter 138, "Of Summary Convictions."

2. If any person or persons shall ride or drive any horse, horned cattle, or other large animal, at a pace faster than a walk over or upon the said Bridge, such person or persons shall for each and every offence forfeit and pay to the said Corporation a sum not more than five pounds and not less than two pounds, to be recovered in the same manner as the penalty hereinbefore imposed.
