(2.) The Secretary of State for India in Council has authorized the Civil Service Commissioners to state that, with the view of meeting the expenses to be incurred by selected Candidates during the interval which must elapse before they can proceed to India, it is his intention to allow the sum of $\pounds 100$ to each selected Candidate who shall have passed the Further Examination in 1863 to the satisfaction of the Commissioners, and shall have complied with such rules as may be laid down for the guidance of selected Candidates.

(3.) Candidates are at liberty to send in their names and evidence of age as soon as they think fit to do so; but evidence of health and character must bear date not earlier than the 1st March 1862.
