

to exercise the powers of Government in or over any Foreign Country, Colony, Province, or part of any Province or People; or if any natural-born subject of His Majesty shall without such leave or licence as aforesaid, engage, contract, or agree to go, or shall go to any Foreign State, Country, Colony, Province, or part of any Province, or to any place beyond the seas, with an intent or in order to enlist or enter himself to serve, or with intent to serve in any warlike or military operations whatever, whether by land or by sea, in the service of or for or under or in aid of any Foreign Prince, State, Potentate, Colony, Province, or part of any Province or People, or in the service of or for or under or in aid of any person or persons exercising or assuming to exercise the powers of Government in or over any Foreign Country, Colony, Province, or part of any Province or People, either as an officer or a soldier, or in any other military capacity, or as an officer or sailor or a marine in any such Ship or Vessel as aforesaid, although no enlisting money or pay or reward shall have been or shall be in any or either of the cases aforesaid actually paid to or received by him, or by any person to or for his use or benefit; in any or either of such cases, every person so offending shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon being convicted thereof upon any information or indictment, shall be punishable by fine and imprisonment, or either of them, at the discretion of the Court before which such offender shall be convicted."

And whereas by Her Majesty's Royal Proclamation, bearing date the thirtieth day of May 1861, Her Majesty was pleased to declare that any natural-born subject of Her Majesty, taking part in the hostilities now unhappily prevailing between the United States of America and certain States styling themselves the Confederate States of North America, would incur Her Majesty's high displeasure, and would receive no protection from Her Majesty against any of the liabilities of his said illegal act:

And whereas I have reason to believe, that notwithstanding the above mentioned Act and Proclamation, certain natural-born subjects of Her Majesty, inhabitants of this Province, have been induced to take part in the afore-mentioned hostilities:—

I have therefore deemed it expedient to publish this my Proclamation, in order to point out clearly to all persons entering the service of either of the above mentioned contending parties, that by so doing they offend against the law; they set at nought the order of their Sovereign, and (even if they escape the legal punishment of their offence), they forfeit the privileges which as Britons they enjoy.

The warning of Her Majesty is solemn and emphatic.

When Her misguided subjects embrace the service of a Foreign State they cast off Her protection, and should they subsequently seek to escape the consequences of their own rash act, they will implore Her mighty aid in vain.

The people of this Province are heartily loyal—I call on them not to disobey the Queen's commands; they reverence the law—I call on them not to violate its provisions; they are prudent and industrious—I call on them not to forsake their homes, and incur risks and hardships in a quarrel which is not their own; forfeiting the favour of their Sovereign and the protection of the British flag, for a precarious subsistence in the armies of a Foreign State.

I appeal to the good feeling and intelligence of the people of New Brunswick. I should wrong them were I to think that the appeal would be made in vain.
