II. All Volunteers competing for the Silver Cup shall be 1 100 acres, lot 41, block 81, Semiwagan Ridge, Daniel Megher. required to appear in the uniform of their corps.

VIII. Each competitor shall fire five shots at each of the ranges, A, B, C; and the prize shall be adjudged according to the aggregate number of points thus made.

IX. In case of a tie, each competitor shall fire one shot at the last range, C, until the best shot be returned.
