the top of the furnace has become red hot, and water coming into contact with this red hot iron has caused the explosion of the boiler. Heard the testimony of the Engineer and Fireman of the Sunbury, and thinks that from the want of a proper attention to his duties, on the part of the Engineer, the explosion may be attributed.

Should there not be an improvement in this respect, His Excellency will feel it his duty to dispense with the services of those Companies, in order to apply more usefully the limited funds at his disposal.
