

YORK GENERAL SESSIONS,
JANUARY TERM, A. D. 1863.

THE following Regulation is adopted and passed by the Court, under the provisions of 25 Victoria, Chapter 17, Section 9, viz:—

Any person who shall, by insulting or abusive language or behaviour, taunting epithets, or threatening gestures, attempt to provoke any other person to commit a breach of the peace, in any public street, thoroughfare, alley, road, or in any building, or whereby a breach of the peace may be occasioned, shall be subject and liable to pay a penalty not exceeding \$8 for every such offence, to be prosecuted, recovered and applied as in and by the said Act and by the Revised Statutes is mentioned.
