2. All Vessels entering the said Port of Saint Stephen, clearing and departing therefrom, shall be exempt from all Duties for the support of Light Houses, Buoys and Beacons,

Hospital Money, Pilotage or other exactions.

3. The regulations and requirements contained in the second and subsequent Sections of Chapter 23, Title III, of the Revised Statutes, so far as the same are applicable, shall apply to this Act, or such other regulations as may from time to time be made by the Governor in Council to facilitate the more beneficial operation of this Act.

4. This Act shall not come into operation or be in force until Her Majesty's Royal approbation shall be thereunto

had and declared.

[This Act was specially confirmed, ratified, and finally enacted by an Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the twelfth day of September 1863.]
