in default of such proof being so furnished, it shall be the duty of the Clerk to report that the Rules and Standing Orders have not been complied with, and to endorse the same upon the Bill.

"That the foregoing Rules be published in the Royal Gazette, over the signature of the Clerk of each House, weekly, during each recess of the Legislature."
