A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by an Inquisition taken by the Coroner of Saint John, on the twenty sixth day of February last, on the body of a new born MALE CHILD, a verdict has been rendered by the Jury of Wilful Murder against some person or persons unknown; I do therefore publish this Proclamation, and offer a Reward of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS to any person or persons who shall give such information as will lead to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons guilty of the alleged murder.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Fredericton, the twenty first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four, and in the twenty seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign.
