The winner of the National Rifle Association Medal is Ensign Wilmot, of Captain Bailey's Company, Sunbury County Militia. This Officer is entitled to fire for Her Majesty's Prize, value £250 sterling, at Wimbledon next year.

The winner of the First Prize competed for by Militia Officers was Ensign J. Duncan, Saint John City Rifles.

His Excellency learns with pleasure that the shooting, particularly for His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales' Cup, was unusually good, though the weather was very unfavourable, which proves that increased attention has been paid to the Theory and Practice of Musketry.

His Excellency hopes that at future Rifle meetings there will be a greater number of competitors for the prizes offered to Militia Officers, whom His Excellency would remind that no proficiency can be attained in Rifle Practice, unless the necessary position and aiming Drill prescribed in Musketry Regulations, is previously performed.
