By His Excellency the Honorable Arthur Hamilton Gordon, Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief of the Province of New Brunswick, the Honorable Sir James Carter, Knight, Chief Justice of the said Province, and the Honorable Robert Parker, one of the Judges of the Supreme Court of the said Province.

To all whom it may concern—Know ye, that in pursuance of the power and authority to us given by virtue of Her Majesty's Commission or Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date the eighteenth day of May, in the first year of Her Majesty's Reign; We have appointed and do hereby appoint a Session to be holden of the Court constituted by the said Commission, pursuant to the several Statutes in such case made and provided, for the trial of all treasons, piracies, felonies, robberies, murders, conspiracies, and other offences whatsoever, and the accessories thereto, done and committed upon the sea and within the jurisdiction of the said Court, on Tuesday the thirtieth day of May next, at the Court House in the City of Saint John in the said Province: Whereof all persons concerned will take due notice.

Witness our hands this twentieth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five.
