"Each person must clear and cultivate not less than two acres, and pay in money or labour, exclusive of Commission, not less than one fourth of the purchase money, before the 9th day of October 1868, or else the approval will be cancelled.

"The Commissioners are required to transmit their annual Returns to this Office on or before the 1st November 1868."
